

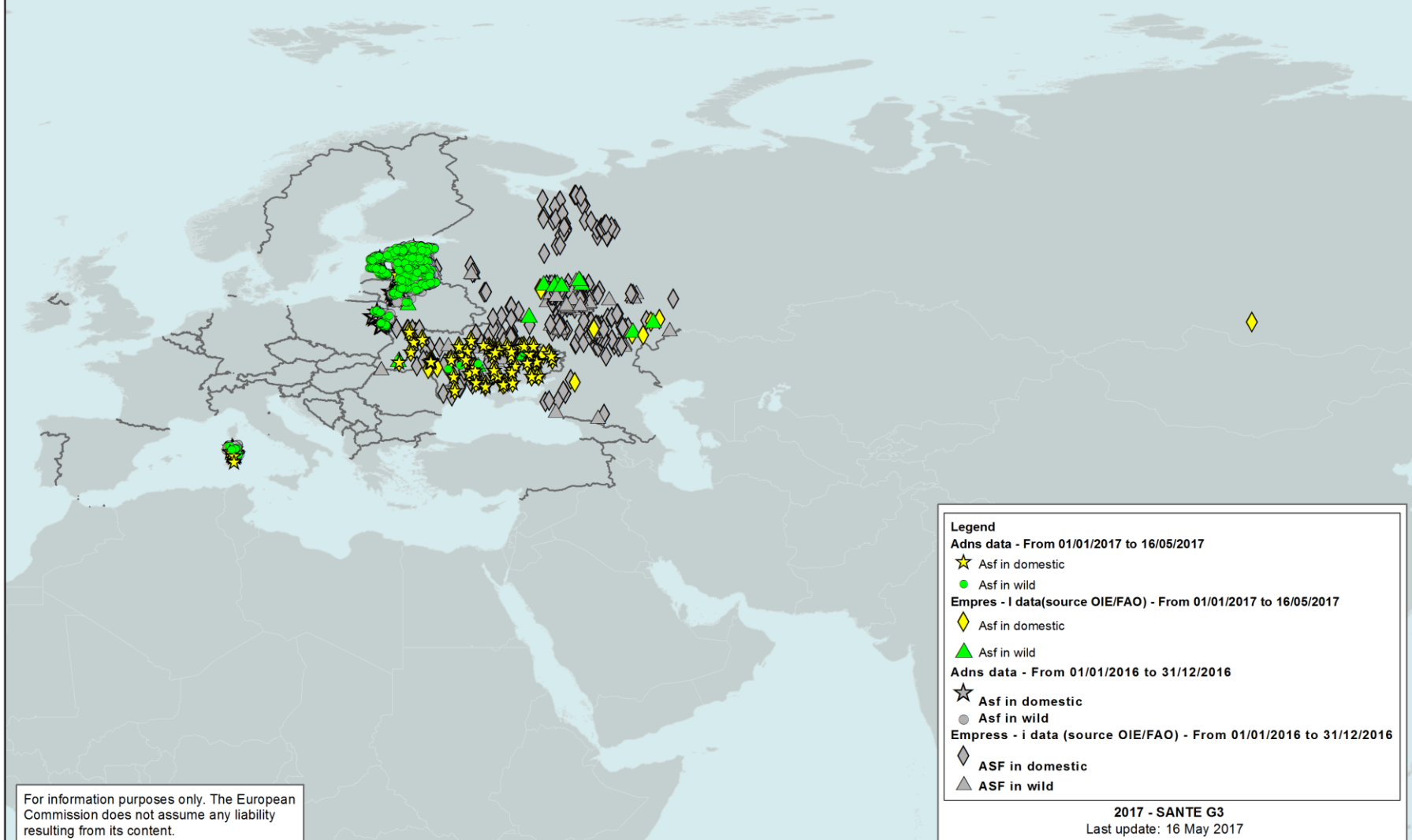

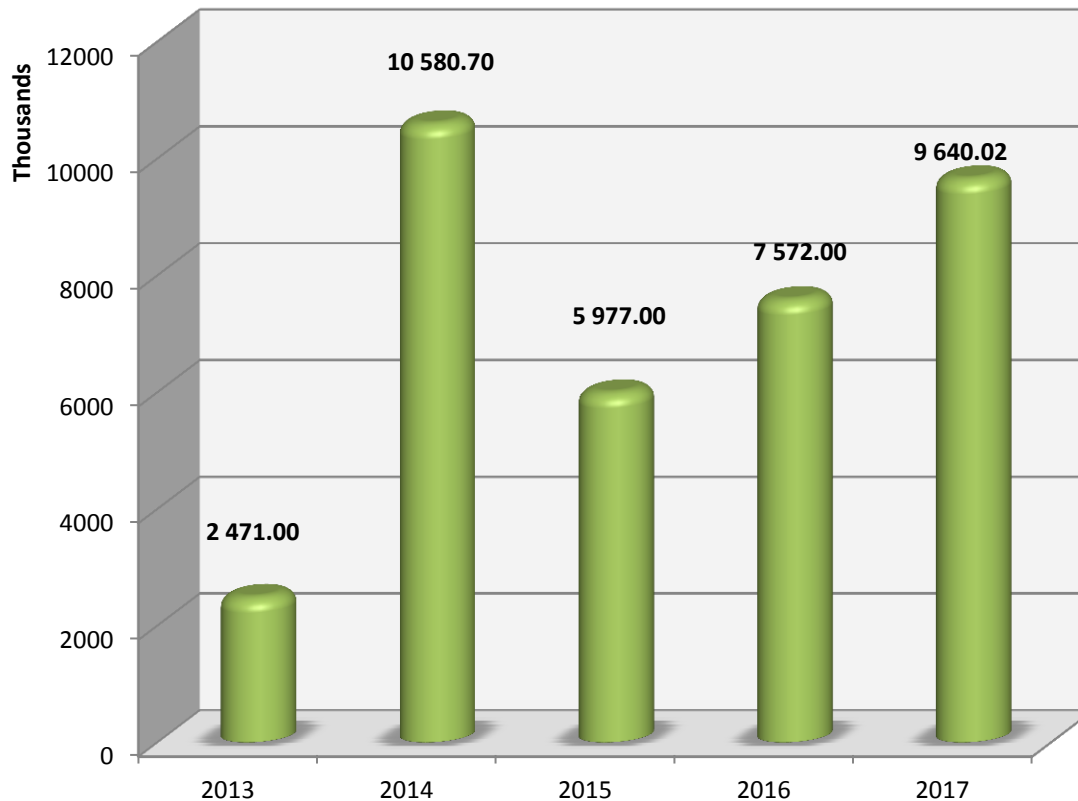


EU funded pilot projects in Ukraine and Moldova

- **Signature is in their final administrative steps**
- **For Ukraine:**
 - **225 000 EUR allocated**
 - **Surveillance and collection of dead wild boars**
 - **In oblasts bordering the EU and Moldova**
- **For Moldova:**
 - **150 000 EUR allocated**
 - **Purchase of material to control the disease**
 - **In the whole country**

EU funds allocated by the EU

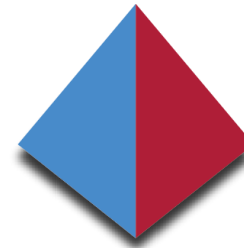
African swine fever: allocation / year



- Maximum amount allocated in 2014 (first cases of ASF in EU)
- Steady increase in the allocation for 2015, 2016, 2017
- 30% increase in 2017
- 36,2 M EUR allocated for the period 2013-2017

The way forward:

- **Building up concrete support as done via pilot projects**
- **Regional coordination under GFTADs (OIE/FAO)**
