

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
ASF outbreaks in 2014 - 2017

ASF cases 2017






Main control measures in domestic pig holdings

- BIOSECURITY
- ENHANCED PASSIVE SURVEILLANCE
- HEALTH CONTROLS clinical and laboratory
- MOVEMENT CONTROLS
- CONTINUOUS AWARENESS



Risk based biosecurity controls – concentrating efforts within and around the commercial holdings





Main control measures in wild boar population

- SAMPLING AND TESTING OF HUNTED WILD BOAR
- SUSTAINABLE FEEDING RESTRICTIONS
- SELECTIVE HUNTING
- CARCASS COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL
- CONTINUOUS AWARENESS



Sampling and testing of hunted wild boar

There is a system in place to provide sampling and testing of all hunted wild boar within the infected area. *There are more than 13 500 hunted wild boar tested in 2016.*

There is an investment provided by the State to comply with carcass storage requirements while waiting for lab results - Latvia managed to allocate 1 million EUR for purchase of refrigerators for hunting grounds







Feeding restriction

Winter feeding is restricted in all territory of Latvia (Regulation of Cabinet of Ministers in place since December 10, 2014)

- Feeding directly on the ground is prohibited
- Use of feeders with dosage option only
- Restrictions on the amount of feed– 400 l to 1000ha





Selective hunting

Targeted female hunting – in the frame of this activity since November 2015 till March 2016 **11 642** female wild boar were hunted.


Since September 2016 till December 2016 **6288** female wild boar were hunted.

Since March 2017 till now **2375** female wild boar are hunted.

Totally - 20 305




Estimated and hunted number of wild boar



Offal and carcass collection and disposal (1)

Offal should be:

- 1. buried on the place
- 2. collected in the special place (pit) at the hunting ground.
- 3. collected in wild boar by-product containers.





Offal and carcass disposal (2)

All found dead wild boars are destroyed:

- 1) Buried in the forest or near by (payment 50 EUR)
- 2) Collected in wild boar by-product containers (payment 30 EUR)
- 3) Transported and destroyed in mobile incinerator unit







BIOSECURITY DURING HUNTING AND IN HUNTING GROUNDS

Food and Veterinary Service in cooperation with State Forest service organize random controls in hunting lodges:

- Storage of carcass till lab results
- Storage conditions
- Disinfectants
- Internal rules for equipment and overalls
- Offal/skin management

Regulation of the Cabinet of Ministers on hunting and hunting ground biosecurity measures is currently drafted.
